

TRAIL CLUES



The trail starts with a grumpy looking lion on the side of the station at **A**

Wander outside onto Exchange Place and look up at the station.

Cross Zetland Road at to see a public art commission, based on the building that houses Bloom at 1 Albert Road. Here you can see the pedestrian crossing that uses the beautiful floral designs from the building.



C is a pattern based on forms from Webb House, can you see where it's from?
There's a wonderful treat in store for you at **D**



Head on inside the Zetland Hotel to find the tiled dining room.



E is less colourful in real life but is still a beautiful floral design.



F is almost as grumpy as the lion, is it because he's just a head?!



Although **G** and **H** are one colour in real life, can you still find them above ornate doors?

You have to look up as high as you can for **I**



You'll soon see that flash of copper green!



The more you look at the more funny faces appear in the brickwork, columns and carved designs on the PD Ports building.



K is a simple doorway on a beautiful building full of history.

Map labels and trail points:

- Streets: LINTHORPE RD, A66, ZETLAND RD, EXCHANGE SQ, ALBERT RD, EXCHANGE PLACE, QUEEN'S SQUARE, BRIDGE ST EAST, LOWER GOSFORD ST, GOSFORD ST, ALBERT ST
- Landmarks: RAILWAY STATION, TRANSPORTER BRIDGE
- Trail Points: A (orange), B (black), C (yellow), D (dark blue), E (light blue), F (yellow), G (red), H (teal), I (teal), J (dark red), K (dark blue)
- Directions: "This way to the town centre" (pointing left), "This way to the Transporter Bridge" (pointing right)

Architectural illustrations connected to the trail:

- Point A: A decorative archway/gate structure.
- Point B: A stylized floral/sunburst design.
- Point C: A colorful, ornate square tile/plaque.
- Point D: A stylized, white, cloud-like/floral design.
- Point E: A colorful, multi-tiered archway/gate structure.
- Point F: A stylized, yellow, textured face or mask.
- Point G: A colorful, multi-tiered archway/gate structure.
- Point H: A decorative, teal, ornate architectural element.
- Point I: A decorative, teal, ornate architectural element.
- Point J: A stylized, red and black, mask-like architectural element.
- Point K: A decorative, teal, ornate architectural element.
